




**PROGRESS**

**COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT:** School nurseries are operated by students and staff from local schools. Their participation strengthens hands-on learning, environmental education, and community commitment to natural resource conservation. These nurseries have become a model of collaboration between schools, the community, and civil society organizations, strengthening both ecological restoration and the social fabric.

**SUSTAINABLE WATER MANAGEMENT**

A 31,000-liter cistern was built, strengthening capacities in the self-construction and management of water storage systems, benefiting 48 individuals and 15 families, and contributing to forest conservation through sustainable practices and reducing pressure on natural water sources.
